To prepare:

It can be helpful to ask the children if they have any questions about veterinary nursing prior to the visit. You could find this out by arranging a call or emailing their teacher prior to your talk.

If you are including activities in your talk, it is useful to have one or two extra tutors/assistants to help supervise this, and to allow an extra 30 minutes to offer adequate time for children to complete the activity and ask questions afterwards.

An example of a talk you could give, and the description of the talk is:

The talk will include a Q&A and some activities at the end to allow the children to engage with some of the topics discussed.
